## The State of Broadband 2016 Report

The Broadband Commission has released their annual report "The State of Broadband 2016: Broadband Catalyzing Sustainable Development". The report looks at the progress made towards the achievement of the Commission's global targets, and an overview of the current state of broadband.

As per the report, six nations, namely China, India, Indonesia, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Nigeria – together account for 55% of the total global population still offline.

The report notes that India has overtaken the United States to become the world's second largest Internet market, with 333 million users, trailing China's 721 million. Recently India even overtook the US to become the world's second-largest smartphone market, with an estimated 260 million mobile broadband subscription and indicating that mobile would drive internet usage in the country.

The Commission argues that if today's near-universal basic mobile phone access could be converted to high-speed mobile broadband access, mobile phones could serve as a major accelerator of development, driving rapid progress towards the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

In terms of household internet penetration, once again the Republic of Korea continues to lead, with 98.8% of homes connected; Qatar (96%) and United Arab Emirates (95%) rank second and third, respectively.

Iceland continues to have the highest percentage of individuals using the Internet (98.2%), while Luxembourg (97.3%) has surpassed Norway to take second place, and Andorra (97%) takes third place from Denmark.

Monaco leads in fixed broadband penetration, at over 47 subscriptions per 100 inhabitants compared with the Swiss figure of 45%.

Finland has the world's highest percentage of active mobile broadband subscriptions, with 144 subscriptions per 100 people, followed by Singapore (142) and Kuwait (139). The Asia-Pacific region accounts for nearly half (48%) of all active mobile broadband subscriptions.

In total, there are now 91 economies where over 50% of the population are online, up from 79 in 2015. But whereas in 2014 the top ten countries for Internet use were all located in Europe, this year sees Bahrain (ranked 7th) and Japan (ranked 9th) join the group. The lowest levels of Internet usage are found in sub-Saharan Africa, with less than 3% of the population using the Internet in a number of countries, including Chad (2.7%), Sierra Leone (2.5%), Niger (2.2%), Somalia (1.8%) and Eritrea (1.1%).

The report predicts that nearly 47 per cent of global population (3.5 Million) will be online by 2016.

### **Stewardship of IANA Functions Transitions to Global Internet Community, as of Contract of ICANN with U.S. Government Ends**

The United States Department of Commerce, National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) has allowed the contract with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN), for performing the Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA) functions, to expire, paving the way for ICANN with the global Internet Community to manage the IANA functions.

Speaking at this historic occasion, ICANN Board Chair Stephen D. Crocker mentioned “This transition was envisioned 18 years ago, yet it was the tireless work of the global Internet community, which drafted the final proposal, that made this a reality. This community validated the multistakeholder model of Internet governance. It has shown that a governance model defined by the inclusion of all voices, including business, academics, technical experts, civil society, governments and many others is the best way to assure that the Internet of tomorrow remains as free, open and accessible as the Internet of today.”

## WTO Public Forum 2016

The WTO Public forum 2016 was held between the 27-29 September 2016. The theme this year was "Inclusive Trade".

This annual Forum is the WTO's flagship event providing a unique platform for heads of state and leading global business people, academics and non-governmental organizations to come together and discuss some of the major trade and development issues of the day. This year marked the 15th anniversary of the Public Forum.

The discussions at the Forum ranged around how to encourage innovation and improve inclusiveness. Allowing small enterprises, women and innovative businesses to take an active role in the global trading system, increasing participation, how the trading system can support innovation and how WTO rules can help to ensure everyone benefits from trade, dominated the discussion. There were discussions on increasing outreach to encourage women to participate in trade, enabling an environment to allow trade to flourish within nations, including removing impediments to free flow of data across borders, protection of privacy, data protection, building trust and confidence to boost digital trade.
